## Modern Slavery Act and Human Trafficking Statement

### 1. Introduction

Whilst not required to provide formal reporting pursuant to section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, Trisco Foods is committed to the prevention of modern slavery and human trafficking from occurring in our business operations and in our supply chains.

### 2. Who we are and what we do

Trisco Foods is an Australian owned family business who have been manufacturing food and beverage products since 1875. Our brands include Tristram's, Trisco, Precise, Enprocal and Venezia (all internationally registered). We export to USA, New Zealand, China, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Vietnam, Taiwan, Cambodia, Thailand, East Timor, Kuala Lumpur, Dubai, Japan, Brunei, Indonesia, Pakistan, Fiji. Trisco is an international sponsor of IDDSI (International Dysphagia Diet Standardisation Initiative) and sits on the Australian steering committee. The Trisco Foods Group has it's head office and main production facility located at 54 Ron Boyle Crescent, Carole Park, Qld 4300. We also have a production facility, Trisco Foods LLC, in Colorado Springs, USA servicing our USA markets.

### 3. Our policies on modern slavery and human trafficking

We have a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery and human trafficking in our business and in our supply chains. This position reflects our top-level commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships. Our position aligns with our values - our values are intrinsic in giving us the focus and direction we need to deliver solutions that improve health outcomes and feed into everything we do.

### 4. Our supply chains

Our principal supply chains are both local and global and whilst we consider the sector within which we operate to be generally low risk, we remain alert to any risks in our business and supply chains. We take steps we deem necessary to detect and eliminate any incidence of modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains, with particular focus on high risk areas. In the event any such incident arises, we will take appropriate remedial action.
